



St Josephs is conscious of concerns raised regarding the taking of video footage or still photographs of players at our courts. However, we are also aware that there are genuine reasons why this may happen, one being the recording of family memories.

In setting a policy with regard to the use of cameras at our courts during games, we feel we have reached a fair and simple compromise.

The following policy shall apply to the use of cameras at St Joseph Netball Courts during the game.

A person is permitted to video and photograph games involving minors provided that they are:

- a) Related to a player involved in the game, or
- b) A designated and approved St Josephs Netball Club Photographer for the purpose of referee development and education.

If parents have concerns about people videoing or taking photographs of junior games, they can raise them with the umpire of the match or a committee member. If the person using a camera is unable to identify their family member they will be asked to discontinue taking photos/filming.

Any person aggrieved by that decision should raise the matter at the earliest opportunity with the St Josephs Netball Committee.

Under no circumstances will videoing or taking of photographs will be permitted within the toilets or changing areas.

Under no circumstances should video footage or photographs taken at St Josephs Netball Courts be posted online or in any public forum without the permission of the parents of all minors appearing in the video or photograph first being obtained.
