



## Registration Policy

Player registrations for Winter season.

All players must be registered to trial. (Trail dates will be communicated with families once set)

Failure to Register on time may result in that player not being included in the first round of trials and this may affect their position in a team/grade.

The following link will allow you to register, noting all SAUCNA affiliated clubs are now required to use the "Play HQ" registration system.

The process is pretty straightforward and it should only take a few minutes.

Please note the following:

- \* Some questions on the registration form have been mandated by Netball Australia eg. What is your favourite Suncorp Netball team.
- \* Please follow the instructions, by first creating a login
- \* If as a parent you have an existing "Play HQ" account, please use this to login and nominate your children/yourself.
- \* Nominations for officials (coach/manager) will need to be made separately.
- \* Please make sure you use your child's CORRECT date of birth eg. NOT 2021
- \* If you intend to use the SA Govt Sports Voucher to pay the major portion of your fees please answer the prompted question " Have you used a Sports Voucher this calendar year " in the payment of fees section as "NO", noting the club will process all vouchers to be claimed in January (ie next calendar year).
- \* please make sure you use your child's CORRECT date of birth eg. NOT 2021
- \* Payment of fees will occur as a part of the registration process.

On completion of the form, you will receive two automated email responses.

1. One indicates that you completed your registration
2. One is a copy of your payment receipt

The registration link will be posted on both our face book and web sites at this same time.

All players are expected to attend both trials, players unable to attend one or both trials are to contact the club secretary [stjoes.secretary@outlook.com](mailto:stjoes.secretary@outlook.com) prior to the commencement of trials to explain their nonattendance.

The President and Secretary will meet during the first week of February to place **registered players only** into teams for trials based on their previous experience and position preferences.

## **Trials Policy**

There will be 2 trials held to ensure that all girls have the opportunity to be seen by selectors. Selectors for trials will be our senior umpiring staff and/or neutral selectors.

All players will have court time in their preferred positions to best show their skill set and strengths to the selectors.

All players will be placed in age appropriate grade first. If necessary to fill a team, a player may be offered a position in a higher level, this will only be done in consultation with the family.

At no time during the trials are parents or coaches to approach the selectors.

Players will be placed in teams based on their previous experience and playing ability. Selectors may request to see more of a player than another at trials, this may happen when they are trying to put teams together and trying different combinations of girls to ensure all teams are evenly balanced.

Placement of players in a teams will be final and families will be notified via email.

*Committee members are not to be contacted regarding the team selections.*

Requests for girls to play together are welcomed, however there will be no guarantees.

Trials will be held at Sacred Heart College Courts, Somerton Park unless notified differently.

### Under 8 and Under 9

"Come and Try" will be run by your club umpires.

Players will be grouped based on their skills and teams will be determined from this.

## **Hot Weather**

Trials will not be cancelled or date moved.

If the weather is forecasted to be above 35c trials will be varied to suit.

Drink breaks will be encouraged.

Shorter court time may be required.

St Joseph's committee will always have the best interest of players at heart.

## **Regrading Policy**

When regrading of teams occurs by Saucna, St Joseph's may also apply changes to teams if it is deemed necessary.

If changes are to be considered, coaches will consult with the secretary, the player & family will be notified.

Changes to teams can only be made if there is a player of whom they can swap.

Once regrading by Saucna has been finalised, teams affected will be notified.

Under no circumstances are coaches, parents etc to contact Saucna in regards to team placement, before or after the regrading process.
